All Sabalo boats are rigged with marine-grade copper-tinned wiring tied to switches with individual breakers. Wires are routed neatly to create more room in compartments and make it easy to add electrical options in the future, and to diagnose electronics failures should they occur. Critical junctions are tied together with water-resistant quick-connectors.

TECHNOLOGICALLY ADVANCED, SUPERIOR MATERIALS, FIRST-CLASS FIT AND FINISH

Standard building material for Sabalo boats is superior grade, uv-resistant polyester resin, Divinycell™ foam coring and Divinycell™ PRX-300 transom board. Vinylester resin and epoxy construction are also available as options.

Hand-laid bi-axial knitted fiberglass is standard on all Sabalo boats in order to increase strength and reduce resin weight. This makes Sabalo boats both lighter and stronger. Kevlar and carbon fiber construction are available as well.

Quality fit and finish combined with “no wood” and virtually unsinkable foam construction make Sabalo boats the perfect choice for discriminating fishermen.
